THE IMPROV CAFÉ

Real issues. Real Conversations. Real funny.



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Based on the World Café conversation model, the Improv Cafe is one of the most democratic forms of theater ever invented. Attendees have small group conversations on a topic or set of questions. Our cast listens in and brings everything they hear from attendees to the stage through improv comedy theater.

What's Needed:

- 30 minutes to 1 hour, depending on event
- Topic or question to discuss
- An audience arranged in small groups or around tables

How it works:

- The audience is arranged into small groups (ideally around tables) and members of The Theater of Public Policy embed themselves throughout the room.
- Using pre-crafted questions or discussion starters, we facilitate a meaningful and productive conversation in each group.
- At the conclusion of the discussion, the cast takes the stage inspired by everything they've heard. Through respectful yet hilarious improv comedy, they recap the various ideas and discussions from throughout the room.
- The result is simultaneously entertaining and empowering for all involved.
- Perfect for community meetings, team building, industry group conferences, educators, and brainstorming sessions.
