We deliver highly interactive workshops to groups large and small. We lead participants through low-risk and very fun exercises that our cast uses in rehearsals to hone their skills as improvisers. In the workshop, we deconstruct each exercise to show how those skills are valuable off stage in the office, city council meeting, classroom, or board room.

The Theater of Public Policy's unique focus in workshops is on what improv can teach us about collaborative and creative problem solving, whether in the private or public sector. We emphasize that improv is less about being funny or quick witted and much more about listening and connecting. It's an ideal tool for leaders looking for a new approach to community problem solving.
