

THE UNSCRIPTED MINNESOTA HOLIDAY



Improv. Holiday. Musical.

This warm, family-friendly, holiday-themed improv show is an annual audience favorite. It can easily be put up at your theater or for a private event. Best of all, it can be customized to incorporate your community, town, or business into the show.

What's Needed:

- 60 to 90 minutes
- A performance space suitable for five improvisers and a keyboardist
- An audience ready to have a festive good time

How it works:

- The audience provides the name of a fictional town and a fictional holiday festival celebrated in that town. For example, "Tonka Town" that celebrates "Yellow Truck Day."
- The cast creates an hour-long unscripted show that tells the story of this town and their quirky annual festival. The story will feel familiar to fans of *It's a Wonderful Life* or *How the Grinch Stole Christmas*.
- One cast member plays the villain—someone who is trying to ruin the town festival for some nefarious reason.
- Ultimately, the cast members playing the members of the town have to save the festival. How exactly they do it is different every show. It's all improvised!
- Perhaps most amazingly of all, this entire show is a musical, and every song is improvised.
